SHORT TITLES

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Licences Ordinance (Amendment) Act 1978.
- (b) The Licences Ordinance 1962-1967 as amended by this Act may be cited as the Licences Act 1922-1978.

COMMENCEMENT

2. This Act shall come into force on a date to be notified by the Cabinet in the Gazette.

AMENDMENT OF LICENCES ORDINANCE 1962-1967

3. (1) The Licences Ordinance 1922-1967 is amended by deleting the Schedule thereto and replacing such Schedule as specified in the Schedule to this Act.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

The licence fees specified in the Schedule to this Bill were fixed in 1955 and it is now appropriate to increase them.

In 1967 the Licences Ordinance 1922-1955 was amended merely by deleting liquor licence fees provided for by the Liquor Ordinance 1967 and remaining fees were not increased.

This Bill does not create any new categories of licence fees.
