To provide for the withdrawal and expenditure of moneys from the Treasury Fund and the Nauru Housing Fund in payment for goods and services obtained or ordered for the Republic during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six.
(Certified: l6th July, 1975)
Enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:

## SHORT TITLE

1. . This Act may be cited as the Finance Act 1975-1976.

## INTERPRETATION

2. In this Act -
"Estimates" means the Estimates of the revenues and expenditure of Nauru for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six prepared and laid before Parliament, a copy of which appear as an Annexure to this Act.

## WITHDRAWAL OF MONEYS FROM THE TREASURY FUND

3. (1) The amount of Twenty-six million six hundred and seventy-four thousand dollars $(\$ 26,674,000)$ may be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended as authorised in the Schedule to this Act and in accordance with the- Estimates in payment for goods and services obtained or ordered for the Republic during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six.
(2) Where the Cabinet considers it necessary to increase the amount assigned in the Estimates to a particular Account within a department, the Cabinet may direct that there shall be applied to the aid of that Account a further sum out of any surplus arising on any other Account within the same department, but so that the total amount withdrawn and expended does not exceed the amount authorised for that department in the Schedule to this Act:
Provided that where the Cabinet authorises a transfer of funds
between Accounts within a department in accordance with this subsection, it shall cause to be laid before Parliament at the first meeting of Parliament after it has approved the transfer, a copy of the Order of the Cabinet approving such transfer.
(3) Where, during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventyfive, any liability has been lawfully incurred to withdraw moneys from the Treasury Fund and to expend them in payment for goods or services obtained or ordered for the Republic during that financial year for any purpose authorised by the Finance Act 1974-1975 or any Supplementary Finance Act in respect of that financial year, and such liability has not been discharged during that financial year, moneys may be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended during that financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six for the purpose of discharging such liability: Provided that the total amount of moneys so withdrawn shall, in no case, exceed the total amount authorised by the said Finance Act and all such Supplementary Finance Acts.
(4) Where the withdrawal of moneys from the Treasury Fund and its expenditure has been authorised by the Finance Act 1974-1975 in respect of any liability incurred for goods or services lawfully obtained or ordered for the Republic under the provisions of any Finance Act or Supplementary Finance Act enacted in respect of any financial year which ended on or before the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four, then if any such liability has not been fully discharged on or before the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five, moneys may be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventysix to discharge that liability.

NAURU HOUSING FUND
4. Where moneys are withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended as authorised in the Schedule to this Act and in accordance with the Estimates or under the provisions of subsection (3) of section 3 of this Act, for the erection, maintenance and repair of Nauruan housing, the Treasury Fund shall be reimbursed from the Nauru Housing Fund to the extent of that expenditure and the Nauru Housing Fund is hereby charged accordingly.

## SUPPLY ACT

5. 

(1) The Supply Act 1975 is hereby repealed.
(2) Where moneys have been expended in accordance with the Supply Act 1975, they shall be deemed to have been expended pursuant to this Act.
