AN ORDINANCE

To revise, amend and repeal certain Ordinances of the Territory

Be it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Nauru, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Nauru Act 1965, as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Ordinances Revision Ordinance 1967.

Commencement.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the <u>Gazette</u>.

 - (d) affect any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment,

and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced, and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed, as if this section had not been included in this Ordinance.
