Enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:

1 Short title
This Act may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Act 2019.

Commencement
This Act commences on certification of the Speaker

Amendment of the Legal Practitioners Act 2019
The Legal Practitioners Act 2019 is amended by the provisions of this Act.

## Amendment of Section 4

Section 4 is amended by deleting and substituting the meaning for 'President' as follows:
'President' means the President of the Law Society who shall be a legal practitioner duly admitted to practice law in the Republic;

## Amendment of Section 20

Section 20(1) is deleted and substituted as follows:

## The clause now reads:

'(1) A practitioner shall not commence practice under his or her own name or a business name:
(a) without any supervision unless he or she has practiced for a minimum period of 3 years after admission to the Supreme Court; and
(b) has practiced under the supervision of a practitioner having practiced for not less than 3 years in the Republic or elsewhere.'
