#### A Bill for:

An Act to provide for the supplementary withdrawal and expenditure of funds from the Treasury Fund to meet the expenditure of the Republic for the financial year ending on 30 June 2011

Certified on....

Enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:

#### 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act 2010-2011.

## 2 Commencement and expiry

- (1) This Act commences on the day it receives the certificate of the Speaker under Article 47.
- (2) This Act expires at the end of 30 June 2011.

### 3 Withdrawal of funds from the Treasury Fund

- (1) An amount not exceeding \$2,364,573 may be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended as authorised in the 4<sup>th</sup> column of the Schedule and detailed in the Supplementary Estimates of Expenditure presented to Parliament on 21 December 2010.
- (2) The amounts in the Schedule are in addition to and not in substitution for the amounts authorised for withdrawal under the *Appropriation Act 2010-2011*.
