BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES ORDINANCE 1957

RECOGNITION OF NAURU INDEPENDENT CHURCH AS A

RELIGIOUS DENOMINATION UNDER SECTION 20

WHEREAS I am satisfied that the Nauru Independent Church has been established in Nauru with a sufficient number of adherents, a separate place of worship and beliefs sufficiently distinct from those of Religious Denominations heretofore recognized under the provisions of Section 20 of the Births, Deaths and Marriages Ordinance 1957

AND WHEREAS I consider it desirable that the Nauru Independent Church should be recognized as a Religious Denomination for the purposes of Section 20 of the said Ordinance

AND WHEREAS Article 3 of the Constitution of Nauru guarantees the fundamental rights and freedoms of each individual to freedom of conscience, of expression and of peaceful assembly and association and I believe it to be consistent with the said Article of the Constitution that the Nauru Independent Church should be recognized as a Religious Denomination under and for the purposes of Section 20 of the said Ordinance.

AND THEREFORE I, LAGUMOT GAGIEMEN NIMEDERE HARRIS, Minister for Internal Affairs and IN EXERCISE of my powers under Section 20 (1) of the Births, Deaths and Marriages Ordinance 1957 DO HEREBY DECLARE the Nauru Independent Church to be a recognized Religious Denomination for the purposes of Section 20 of the said Ordinance and to the intent that Ministers belonging to the Nauru Independent Church may be empowered, subject to sub-section (3) of the said Section, to solemnize marriages in Nauru.
