Any other remaining blocks of lands owned or shared by late Eugenius Denea deceased should be now distributed in the following manner:-

- (a) Blocks inherited by late Eugenius Denea from his wife the late Eikaben deceased, should be equally owned and shared by Eibogoneida and Ruba H.
- (b) Blocks solely owned or shared by late Eugenius Denea should be equally owned and shared by Agakar and Eigoriedu for the duration of her life time only. Upon her death, her shares will revert to Agakar.
- (c) A block simply known and called "AMAEQ" phosphate land in Anibare or Ijuw, which at the present is under the consideration of the Lands Committee and the Survey Department, should be awarded to Akarangu Dongobir, in accordance to the wish of late Eugenius Denea, as per Minute Book 1964, page 25.
