CORPORATION ACT 1972

CORPORATION (FORMS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1978

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on it by section 243 of the Corporation Act 1972, the Cabinet has made the following regulations :

G.N. No. 90/1978 (cont'd)

TITLE

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Corporations (Forms) (Amendment) Regulations 1978.

THE PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

2. In these Regulations "the principal Regulations" means the Corporations (Forms) Regulations 1972.

AMENDMENT TO THE FIRST SCHEDULE TO THE PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

3. The First Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by adding to the second entry in the second column thereof immediately after the words "Application by corporation" the words "or firm".

AMENDMENT OF THE SECOND SCHEDULE TO THE PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

4. The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by deleting therefrom Form No. CORP/20 and by inserting in lieu thereof the following new Form No. CORP/20.
