NAURU PUBLIC SERVICE  
VACANCIES

The following permanent positions in the Nauru Public Service are either vacant or occupied temporarily by temporary employees. Applications are invited both from persons outside the Service and from serving temporary employees for permanent appointment to these positions.



Permanent officers of the Service may make application for promotion or transfer to any vacant position.

Headquarters Staff

Clerk (£243-587), Records Office.

Duties: Assist Records Officer in filing all inward and outward correspondence, despatch of mails and distribution of files.

Typist (F) Gr.I (£194-456) Typing Pool (3 vacancies).

Duties: Typing duties as directed by the Typist-in-Charge.

Clerk (£613-715) Accounts

Main duties - As Paymaster, responsible for the accuracy in the preparation of payrolls, dissecting deductions from salaries made in accordance with authorities held, and the accuracy of odd payments in the nature of salaries and allowances.

Applicants should have had experience in accounting work and possess a high degree of accuracy in computation and calculating work.

Clerk (£536-639)

Main duties - As Orders Clerk, responsible for the preparation and follow-up of local and overseas orders for supplies, checking and dissecting claims for goods supplied.
