TERRITORY OF NAURU

Importation of Pigs and Pigmeats from Australia.

WHEREAS by Section 46(8) of the Customs Ordinance 1921 of the Territory of New Guinea (Adopted) it is provided that the Administrator may by proclamation prohibit the import of goods,

AND WHEREAS by notice published in the Government Gazette of 1st July 1961, His Honour the Administrator of Nauru prohibited the import from Australia of pigs and pigmeats,

NOW I, FREDERICK WILLIAM McCONAGHY, Acting Administrator of Nauru, hereby revoke the aforesaid prohibition on import from Australia of pigs and pigmeats.

1965 CORRESPONDENCE COURSES

All persons intending to take Correspondence Courses next year, 1965, are requested now to obtain a Form of enrolment from the Clerk at the Education Office. This Form must be completed and handed in with the necessary enrolment fees to the Accounts Branch before Tuesday, 27th October. The receipt and the Form are then to be handed to Mr. G. Szonyi, Supervisor of Correspondence Classes.

Should any applicant be in doubt about a choice of subjects, please interview Mr. Szonyi for advice.

Registration of students now is necessary to ensure arrival on time next year of correspondence notes necessary for the course.

The following is a summary of steps which should be taken for enrolment:

1. Decide on the subjects you intend to study on correspondence in 1965. Obtain Enrolment Form from the Clerk at Education Office, and complete it as soon as possible.
2. Pay registration fees to the Accounts Branch before 27th October 1964.
3. Bring Enrolment Form and Accounts receipt to Mr. Szonyi.

The Education Department will complete arrangements for enrolment and classes and inform applicants in due course.
