POSTAGE STAMP DESIGN COMPETITION

It is notified for public information that a postage stamp design competition is being conducted by the Administration of Nauru.

The following are the rules and conditions of this competition :

1. The competition is open to all residents of Nauru of any age or either sex.
2. There shall be no limit to the number of individual entries submitted and no entry fee will be charged.
3. Designs may be sketches, water-colour or oil paintings, pen and ink drawings or photographs but the dimensions of entries must not exceed 15" x 15" nor be less than 10" x 10", suitable for reproduction in the size of a normal postage stamp.
4. Designs should be original and should depict some scene, subject or activity which may be seen on, but not necessarily peculiar to, Nauru.
5. Entries must be submitted to the Official Secretary, Administration Headquarters, no later than 4.30 p.m. Friday 31st May, 1963.
6. Each entry must bear the full name and address of the competitor on the reverse side.
7. All entries will become and remain the property of the Administration to be dealt with at its discretion.
8. Entries will be adjudged by a Committee set up by the Administrator. Points will be awarded for originality, design and layout, artistic quality, and suitability for reproduction as a postage stamp for Nauru. The Committee's majority decision shall be final.
9. Entries may be submitted by members of the Committee but such entries shall not be eligible for prizes.
10. A prize of £25 and a presentation proof copy of the stamp for which the design is used shall be awarded to the winning entry. A prize of £10 and a presentation proof copy of the stamp for which the design is used shall be awarded to the entry judged second. A prize of £5 shall be awarded for any other design which may be used.
11. Winning entries will be announced in the Government Gazette in due course.

NOTE : The following stamp design subjects have already been approved for future stamp issues : Tomano Blossom (Calophyllum, Nauruan name - Iyo); Nauru Orchid (Capparis, Nauruan name - Ekabobwiya); Black Lizard; Coral Pinnacles (beach scene); Nauru canary (Acrocephalus Inscinia Rehsei). Competition entries with these subjects as main features would not be rated high for originality by the judges.
