Duties

The successful applicant, who will be responsible to the Director of Works, will be required to provide general assistance in the planning, co-ordination and management of new constructions and repairs and maintenance of Administration buildings, houses and civil undertakings within the Territory.

He will also be required to prepare designs and specifications for construction of buildings of average complexity and quantity assessments for such works, assist in the general organisation and control of the joinery and other Sections of the Department of Works associated with building construction and maintenance, perform on-the-job supervision of new works and maintenance projects, direct office and field labour forces, train direct labour force in connection with above duties, and provide administrative assistance to the Director of Works in the preparation of works projects and progress reports, orders for building materials and the like.
