THE CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY

FOR BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT

(ARTICLE 23)

BY VIRTUE of the powers in that behalf vested in me under Article 23 of the Constitution of Nauru and of all other powers me enabling I BERNARD DOWIYOGO President of the Republic of Nauru HEREBY ASSIGN to the Ministers of the Cabinet named below the responsibility for the business of the Government of Nauru as set out hereunder opposite the respective names of such Ministers:-

folio of Minister Assistant to
the President.

The Portfolio of Health and
Education.

The Portfolio of Works and
Community Services.

This assignment shall be effective from the 31st day of December, 1976 until revoked or varied.
