NAOERO POSTAL SERVICES CORPORATION BILL 2018 SECOND READING SPEECH

I introduce to this House today a Bill for an Act to establish the Naoero Postal Services Corporation.

Mr Speaker, this Bill aims to ensure that efficient postal services and sale of postal services related merchandise are provided in the Republic. This is essential for the expansion of industry and commerce.
