Gaming Regulations 2011

Notified on 2 December 2011

Cabinet makes the following regulations under section 31 of the *Gaming Act 2011*:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Gaming Regulations 2011*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 3 December 2011.

3 Licence fees

For the definition of '*licence fee*' in section 3 of the Act, the licence fee for a gaming licence to conduct a game specified in Schedule 1, column 2 for the duration specified opposite in column 3 is the amount specified opposite in column 4.

4 Prescribed form

For section 5(2)(a) of the Act, the prescribed form for an application for a gaming licence is set out in Schedule 2.

5 Exempt games – raffles and karti

For section 4(1)(d) of the Act, the amount prescribed is \$250.

Note for regulation 5

This means that a raffle or game of karti for which the total value of prizes offered is less than \$250 is an exempt game under the Act.

6 Transitional matter – games other than bingo

- (1) This regulation applies to a game mentioned in section 5(1) of the Act, other than bingo, that is conducted:
 - (a) after the commencement of these Regulations; and
 - (b) before 1 April 2012.
- (2) The game is taken to be conducted in accordance with a gaming licence.
- (3) This regulation expires on 1 April 2012.

Note for regulation 6

This means that the game is an exempt game until 1 April 2012. If the person who conducts the game does not hold a gaming licence to conduct the game before 1 April 2012 and continues to conduct the game, the game will no longer be an exempt game and will instead be an unlawful game.
