Animals (Amendment) Regulations 2008¹

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 18 and 20 of the *Animals Act 1982* and all other powers in this regard, Cabinet hereby makes the following regulations –

1. SHORT TITLE

These Regulations may be cited as the Animals (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

2. INTERPRETATION

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires –

"the Act" means the Animals Act 1982;

3. PURPOSE

The purpose of these Regulations is to amend the Animals Regulations 2000 to remove the requirement for an import licence for live animals.

4. AMENDMENT OF ANIMALS REGULATIONS 2000

- (1) Regulation 3. of the Animals Regulations 2000 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:
- "3. The application of section 11 of the Act is hereby extended to all animals."
- (2) Regulation 4. of the Animals Regulations 2000 and Schedule 1 to the Animals Regulations 2000 are hereby repealed and replaced with the following:
- "4. Pursuant to subsection 4(2) of the Act, the fee payable for a licence for keeping a dog is \$50.00."
