PRACTICE NOTE NO. 1 OF 2003

SERVICE OF DOCUMENTS IN CIVIL MATTERS

- 1. It has come to the notice of the Court that there have been occasions wereby parties have filed documents in civil matters or causes and these documents were not served on the other parties to the matter or causes. Nor is there any return of service where documents have been served.
- 2. The responsibility for service of documents lies with the party filing the document in the court registry. It is not the responsibility of the court nor its staff to serve document in civil matters or causes.
- 3. The party concerned in accordance with Order 42 of the Civil Procedure Rules 1972 must serve document.
- 4. When a document is filed the court registry staff will register the document in accordance with registry practice and will retain the original on the court file. At least two copies are filed with the original and these two copies will be registered and return to the party who filed the documents.
- 5. Where more than two copies are required, depending on the number of parties involved, then sufficient copies should be presented for registration. The copies will be returned to the party for purposes of service on other parties.
- 6. Following service of the documents, an affidavit of service of document should then be filed with the court registry as evidence of service. See: Rule 42(7).
- 7. Service of document on the President, Cabinet, Ministers or a public officer in his official capacity shall be served on the Secretary for Justice as the Nominal Defendant.

COURTS ACT 1972 COUNSELS DRESS ORDER 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 71 of the Courts Act 1972, I herein order that the dress to be worn by barristers and solicitors and by pleaders appearing before the Supreme Court or District Court Shall be as follows: -

DISTRICT COURT

Barristers & Solicitors & Pleaders

(a) in the case of male person, a lounge suite of plain sober colour with a collared shirt and tie

and

(b) in the case of female persons, a dress, or white blouse and skirt or tailored slacks, of plain sober colour.

SUPREME COURT

(a) <u>Civil Trials</u> (including Land Appeals, Constitutional references, and civil and criminal appeals) Barristers & Solicitors – robes without wigs. Pleaders – black gown over dress for District Court.

(b) Criminal Trials

Barristers & Solicitors – robes with wigs. Pleaders- black gown over dress for District Court.

(c) <u>Chamber matters, Call Overs, Special Case hearings, and Tribunals</u> Barristers & Solicitors and Pleaders as for District Court.

The dress code described above will operate as and from May 1st 2003, in both the District and Supreme Court. Barristers and Solicitors will note that wigs have henceforth been dispersed with apart from criminal trials. In future, the bench will not wear wigs except for criminal trials. On formal occasions, such as the Opening of the Legal Year, the Bench and Bar, excluding, Pleaders will be expected to wear full robes with wigs.

The Counsel's Dress order 1973 contained in G.N.No. 77/1973 is hereby repealed.
